We invite you to get vaccinated against COVID-19.

Below you will find all the necessary information about your vaccination.

Even if you have already been contacted by e-mail or SMS, it is intended that all citizens receive the letter below.

If you already have an appointment or have already been vaccinated, please disregard this letter.

The vaccine is <u>free</u> of charge and is voluntary.

HOW do I make an appointment?

Make an appointment before

with your personal vaccination code above.

- Preferably via the website <u>www.jemevaccine.be</u>
- Or you can scan the QR code above. To do this, you must first install the QR code application on your phone.
- Or by telephone.

When you make an appointment, you will be able to choose among the centres that will be proposed to you, and then the date and time of your vaccination.

In concrete terms, the vaccination process is as follows:

WHAT SHOULD BE DONE if you can't get to the vaccination centre because you have MOBILITY PROBLEMS?

- Ask those around you for help.
- Most public transport is free of charge upon presentation of the invitation and the confirmation of the appointment.
- ▶ Local travel solutions are available: ask your municipality or the CPAS for information.



Are there any CONTRAINDICATIONS to vaccination?

The contraindications for vaccination against COVID-19 are rare.

If as a result of a previous vaccination or in other circumstances, you have had a <u>severe</u> allergic reaction or needed urgent medical attention, contact your doctor for more information.

If you are currently suffering from an infection <u>or</u> have a fever (38° or higher), postpone your vaccination appointment until you are fully recovered.

If you have had a positive Coronavirus test in the last 14 days, whether or not you have any symptoms, contact your doctor and reschedule your vaccination appointment for 14 days after your recovery.

What to do ON THE DAY OF YOUR VACCINATION?

- ▶ Take <u>this letter</u> with you, which contains **your personal code**.
- ▶ Please have the medical questionnaire attached to this letter ready, duly completed.
- Please bring your identity card with you .
- ▶ Wear **a surgical or cloth mask**, **NOT** a bandana or scarf.
- Wear clothing that makes it easy to reach your upper arm.
- ▶ Come alone, <u>unless</u> you need assistance to get around.
- If you are ill, do not come. Instead, make a new appointment (see above).
